Saturday 17th August Lytham 1940s Weekend

There'll be music and dancing, including song from George Formby, an impressive display of historic military vehicles, a vehicle procession led by Winston Churchill, and a static Spitfire display. Plus, Spirit of the Home Front and many and varied re-enactment groups, including a canon firing display! **£20pp**



Saturday 24th August Llandudno- Heading to the Welsh coast to the pier which has Punch and Judy and Donkey Man. Or maybe visit Swallow Falls, the impressive Conway Castle or Britain's smallest house. ***1 hour Early Start* £25pp**

Tuesday 27th August Settle Market- At the historic Market Place, there's a wide variety of wares, from fruits, veg and cakes to bag, local craft and fashions. You can explore the quirky independent shops and explore the historic town. **£20pp**

Saturday 31st August Vintage by the Sea-Morecambe



Step back in time and enjoy Art and Culture from the 20s-90s. There will be street theatre, a vintage marketplace, a classic car show, a Vintage Hair and Beauty Salon for classic make over, a Vintage Fairground and Vintage Mobile Cinema.
